HISTORY

The provincial university was inaugurated publicly on April 18, 1897 and extended its academic life until 1905. It began to operate with three faculties and a School of Midwives. The National Minister of Justice and Public Instruction, Dr. Joaquín Víctor González, conceived the idea of nationalizing it, providing the capital of the province with a modern, scientific-based university. Thus, on September 19, 1905, the law number 4699 was sanctioned. On March 17, 1906, Dr. Joaquín V. González was designated as first President of UNLP, and from then on he began his sustained growth, incorporating institutes and creating Schools and Faculties. The UNLP took prestige as one of the most advanced institutions inside and outside the country. The principles of respect, freedom and justice that drove the movement of the University Reform in 1918, found an echo in the La Plata university community. The educational contents to be imparted coincided with the new paradigm of the Reform University, based on the empirical support of knowledge and the distancing of all dogmatism.



CHARACTERISTICS



The icon is constituted by two oak leaves joined at its base. It was adopted in 1906 and designed by Prof. Enrique Herrero Ducloux. According to Greek mythology, oak is the tree consecrated to Zeus, directly related to Pallas Athena, goddess of wisdom, science, art and industry, and also a symbol of firmness, vigor, severity and permanence.

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR EU PASSPORT HOLDERS

We recommend you to start the process for a “non-Mercosur Visa for partial studies” in advance at your country’s consulate.

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR EU PASSPORT HOLDERS

Day of the interview:

1. **Valid passport:** >six (6) months since you enter the country, at least two clean pages.
1. **Two (2) pictures:** in colour, white background, 4x4cm, recently taken from the front.
1. **Visa application form** DIGITALLY COMPLETED , NOT SIGNED.
1. **Copy of the degree program** (not necessarily legalised).
1. **Electronic data preloaded** by your home University to the National Directorate of Migration (DNM).

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR EU PASSPORT HOLDERS

5. **Copy of the proof of enrollment at UNLP** at the National Registry of Foreign Requirements (RENURE).

5. **Accreditation of sufficient financial resources** to afford your stay and studies (Consulate authority may ask for bank account summary, credit card and other documentation).

5. For stays longer than six (6) months:
 - a. **Criminal record certificate** issued by the competent authority of the countries where you have resided for more than 1 year during the last 3 years (with apostille or legalised).
 - b. Commitment to tell the truth or **sworn statement of lack of criminal records in other countries**, signed before the Argentine consulate.

La Plata, capital of the province of Buenos Aires, is located about 60 kilometers south of the Autonomous City of Buenos Aires, and has a population of around 750 thousand inhabitants, which makes it the fourth largest populated city in the country.

Founded on November 19, 1882, it is characterized as one of the few cities in the world to be designed before being built. La Plata is a university metropolis that offers a great educational, scientific and cultural pole of excellence.




