


Certificate Programme „Building International Careers“ winter 2019/20



Description „Building International Career“

The certificate programme „Building International Careers“ is preparing international and German students of all disciplines for the requirements of the global job market. Launched in summer term 2018, more than 180 BA and MA students applied for a participation. Having adapted the concept and methods each semester based on the evaluation results and the needs of the target group, the objectives of the programme are:

- Knowing personal interests, competences and strengths for global working perspectives
- Planning and preparing a career abroad (research strategies for jobs, application documents, interview situations)
- Becoming part of an international learning community that focusses on international working contexts

Every student who registers online with a high degree of motivation and applies successfully with a preparation task, will be part of the programme. To gain the „Certificate International“, the following elements are required:

- Participation in the kick-off-workshop and the final workshop (with presentation)
- Completing the online-modules I and II and III or IV
- Engagement within the peer-group-meetings
- An Intercultural competence training and an intercultural engagement (InDiGU)

Innovative Developments

- Blended Learning methods with flexible timeframe
- Online elements with Open Source Materials (“career modules”) and Q&A Webinars
- Peer-to-peer coaching in person and online via “Rocket-Chat”
- Initiating a digital community for an intercultural exchange with career related content

Evaluation
